
What is Adoration?

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration is the adoration of Jesus Christ present in the Holy Eucharist.

In the many churches that have this devotion, the Eucharist is displayed in a special holder called a monstrance, and people come to pray and worship Jesus continually throughout the day and often the night.

Christ's great love for us was shown when he was crucified to pay the ultimate penalty for our sins and give us eternal life. He loves us without limit, and offers Himself to us in the Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist.

Adoration at Immaculate Conception

Eucharistic Adoration began at Immaculate Conception in 2002 on the Feast of the Assumption.

The Saint John Paul II Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration Chapel is located on the first floor at the east end of the former convent, now the Parish Education Center, next to the Marian grotto. The chapel is open 24 hours a day, seven days per week, 365 days per year.

The chapel is open to anyone who desires to spend quiet time in prayer, meditation or reading. Adorers willing to make a weekly, one-hour commitment are most welcome and can do so by returning the form on this flyer or logging on to the Parish web site and downloading the registration form there. As you visit our web site, please consider submitting an online prayer request. All prayer requests are taken to the Adoration Chapel, where adorers will pray for your intentions.

Our goal in the Adoration Program is to have all of the hours during the week covered by at least two separate prayer partners, as this will provide the best coverage for unexpected absences and conflicting schedules.

The program also provides space for those who find it difficult to dedicate that hour each week to our Lord by offering individuals the option of placing their name on the active e-mail substitute list. Substitutes volunteer to fill in for others who cannot commit to their scheduled hour on a particular day.
