SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

Following a live-streamed, online Mass viewing is an opportunity for the faithful to remain connected to the Sacrifice of the Mass during this difficult time. Pope Francis, after reciting a livestreamed Angelus prayer March 15, told people, "United to Christ we are never alone, but instead form one body, of which he is the head. It is a union that is nourished with prayer and also with spiritual communion in the Eucharist, a practice that is recommended when it isn't possible to receive the sacrament."

Here is the Act of Spiritual Communion written by St. Alphonsus de Liguori:

and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment
receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself

The Fifth Sunday of Lent

Catechism Corner

“Christ will raise us up ‘on the last day’; but it is also true that, in a certain way, we have already risen with Christ. For, by virtue of the Holy Spirit, Christian life is already now on earth a participation in the death and Resurrection of Christ:

“And you were buried with him in Baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead...If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.” [Col. 2:12; 3:1] (CCC, 1002)

The Catechism of the Catholic Church

Spend time in prayer this week and ask God to reveal those places within you that God wants to “raise up and redeem.” Allow the Lord to accomplish His will for you. Listen to the Lord say; “With the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption;” [Ps. 130] and ‘O my people! I will put my spirit in you that you may live, and I will settle you upon your land; thus you shall know that I am the Lord. I have promised, and I will do it, says the Lord.’ [Ez. 37:12-14]

As a meditation, speak from your heart the words from scripture; “Master, the one you love is ill.” Listen as God says; “I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?” Then ask God into those areas that need healing by saying; “Sir, come and see.” Listen as Jesus weeps with you over your brokenness, and rejoices, knowing that He will raise you up. Hear Him say your name followed by, “Come out!” And then hear Jesus say; “Untie her/him and let her/him go.” [Jn. 11:1-45]

Take some moments in thanksgiving for God’s healing grace flowing upon and within you. Breathe in God’s redeeming love and care for you.

St. Isidore of Seville 560 – April 4, 636–Feast day—April 4 *Saint Watch*

This bishop’s extensive writings influenced church thinking for a millennium. As bishop of Seville, Spain, from about 600 until his death, he presided over two councils, promoted acceptance of the “filioque” clause of the Creed, and battled the Arian heresy. He wrote a history of the barbarian invasions of Spain and compiled in “The Etymologiae” all that was known in his time. Nearing death, he gave away everything he had, confessed his faults to his people in church, and received Communion. Pope John XXIII admired his ideas about the ideal bishop, notably that “Every bishop should be distinguished as much by his humility as by his authority.” A Doctor of the Church, Isidore is the patron saint of computer users. www.usccb/currentcatholic.org
