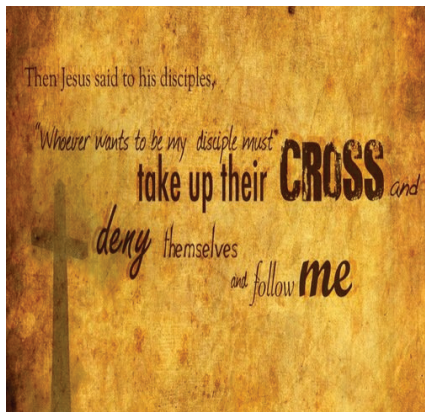

While some people may state that they are willing to lose their life for Jesus, the actions they display are not reflective of someone who will sacrifice the very character of their humanness. **Jesus, the Son of God, was our living, walking example on this earth of what encompasses complete sacrifice.** If we are honest with ourselves, we can probably understand how difficult it is for us to accomplish this command of our Savior.

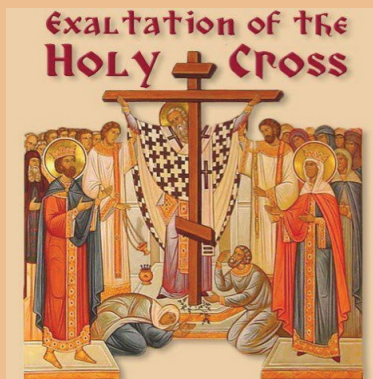
How can we lose our life and take up our cross daily to follow Jesus? For me, it begins with a change of attitude, which can be easier said than done. The attitude that is needed is one of dropping to my knees and crying out loud that I need God in every aspect of everything I ever do. While my morning prayers include me asking God to use me to be the light that others might see Him through my daily actions, this is where I get stuck, I get stuck in my own thoughts and it's at that moment I realize that I am not that light I want others to see. It's easier said than done! Lord, give us the grace to deny ourselves and take up our cross.

The Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows falls on September 15. This feast commemorates the sorrowful Mother and the sufferings she experienced in union with her Son and dates back to the 12th century. The feast was extended to the universal Church in 1817 by Pope Pius VII and fixed officially in the calendar for September 15 in 1913 by Pope Pius X. This feast reminds us of the spiritual martyrdom of Our Blessed Mother and her compassion with the sufferings of her divine Son. Through her great sufferings as co-redeemer, she also helps to show us the true evil of sin and thereby leads us to repentance and salvation. From the Roman Missal



We adore you, O Christ, and we praise you, because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world!

The feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross celebrates two historical events: the discovery of the True Cross by Saint Helena, the mother of the Emperor Constantine, in 320 under the temple of Venus in Jerusalem, and the dedication in 335 of the basilica and shrine built on Calvary by Constantine, which mark the site of the Crucifixion.

However the feast, more than anything else, is a celebration and commemoration of God's greatest work: his salvific death on the Cross and His Resurrection, through which death was defeated and the doors to Heaven opened.
