


THE DISCIPLE MAKER INDEX (DMI) PARISH SURVEY – WE ARE WAITING TO HEAR FROM YOU

John 10:11-18: I am the good shepherd who sacrifices his life for the sheep, unlike a hired hand who runs when danger comes. I know my sheep and they know me. I also have other sheep not of this pen; they will listen to my voice, making one flock under one shepherd. I lay down my life voluntarily, with the authority to take it up again, as commanded by my Father.



The 4th Sunday of Easter Year known as Good Shepherd Sunday, features readings that collectively underscore Jesus' role as the Good Shepherd, His sacrificial love, and our identity as God's beloved children. Through Peter's declaration, and the deep love revealed in 1 John, the scripture passages illuminate our salvation through Christ, our cherished relationship with God, and the inclusivity of Jesus' call. These readings culminate in the Gospel, where Jesus emphasizes His voluntary sacrifice and deep, personal connection with His flock, inviting us to reflect on our faith and mission within the universal Church. youngcatholic.org

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS



The World Day of Prayer for Vocations is an annual observance designated by the visionary Pope Paul VI in 1964. It falls on the fourth Sunday of Easter, also known as Good Shepherd Sunday due to the Gospel readings. On this day, the faithful are encouraged to pray for an increase in priestly and religious vocations, following the Lord's instruction to "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest" (Matthew 9:38; Luke 10:2) vianneyvocations.org

US Diocese of Columbus doubles number of seminarians in two years.



As Pope Francis releases his message for the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, Bishop Earl Fernandes from the Diocese of Columbus, in the US state of Ohio, describes how renewed pastoral efforts and prayer have led 16 new men to enter the diocesan seminary last year, with 12 more expected this year. He also highlighted the importance of prayer on the part of lay faithful, as well as women and men religious, in the diocese.
