Jesus described himself as the true vine and his Father as the gardener. Branches not bearing fruit are removed, while fruitful ones are pruned for more yield. He emphasized staying connected to him, akin to branches on a vine, as the key to bearing fruit. Without him, nothing can be achieved. Unfruitful branches are discarded. Fruitfulness in believers brings glory to God and proves discipleship.

The Gospel presents us with the beautiful metaphor of the vine and the branches. Jesus emphasizes the importance of remaining in Him to bear fruit. Like branches that cannot survive, let alone bear fruit when severed from the vine, our spiritual lives wither without a deep and sustaining connection to Christ. This imagery invites us to consider the nature of the fruit we're called to bear. It's not merely about individual accomplishments but about contributing to the flourishing of the whole community, to the glory of God. youngcatholic.org

Eucharist-centered?

Being Eucharist-centered can seem like a concept that is hard to get our minds around, but for Archbishop Thompson, it starts simply. "Eucharist means to give thanks, so first and foremost, how can we be a grateful people? Like Pope Francis says, Christians should not look like they are always coming back from a funeral. We should have the joy of the Gospel. How will we take the joy of the Congress back with us with a sense of gratitude in such a way that we take nothing for granted? Imagine if all of us exuded that joy, that belief, that conviction, our enthusiasm, and our faith in the Eucharist not only in what we say but also in how we live it out."
