





What is a doctor of the Church?

A saint whose teachings have made an extraordinary impact on Catholic thought...

A Doctor of the Church is a saint whose teachings have made an extraordinary impact on Catholic thought, deepening our understanding of the Faith.

To receive this title, a saint must meet three criteria:

- 1. Their teachings must be theologically sound and beneficial to the Church.
- 2. They must have shown remarkable holiness of life.
- 3. They must be officially proclaimed a Doctor by the pope or an ecumenical council. In other words, Doctors of the Church aren't just smart—they're holy. Their wisdom is paired with deep love for Christ and His Church.

The very first four Doctors—St. Ambrose, St. Jerome, St. Augustine, and St. Gregory the Great—were declared in the 13th century by Pope Boniface VIII. Later, two remarkable women joined their ranks: St. Teresa of Ávila and St. Catherine of Siena, named in 1970 by Pope Paul VI.

On November 2, St. John Henry Newman—the brilliant convert, writer, and theologian—was officially the newest Doctor of the Church. Newman's life and writings have inspired countless Catholics to seek truth with both faith and reason, showing that intellect and holiness belong together.

OPEN SHELTER MEAL - MONDAY, DECEMBER 1



5TH SUNDAY COLLECTION -** SOCIETY OF VINCENTIANS IN ACTION!

Your SVdP conference at Immaculate Conception has helped 35 families with utility and rental assistance. In each case, the assistance was provided as the result of a home visit by two Vincentians for our conference. One of the hallmarks of the Society is the home visit. We do not just funnel support, we meet with the neighbor, listen to their immediate need and to their deeper needs. We try to offer immediate short term (band aid) support, pointing them to additional resources and financial counseling. In addition, we provided 900 sandwiches to the Holy Family Soup Kitchen, made by our conference on the 4th Monday of each month. Each Friday, we make food calls to neighbors who are having trouble with both a shortage of food and an inability get out to stores and food pantries. These shut-in food deliveries include food from our pantry and some fresh items purchased at the local grocery and delivered. Each week, we serve between 4 to 6 of these neighbors. We are also providing the Bishop Griffin Center and Clintonville Resource Center with turkeys for Thanksgiving.

Your contributions and food donations make it possible for IC Vincentians to help people with financial challenges. The last 5th Sunday Collection for this year is the weekend of November 29 and 30. However, donations to our IC Conference can be made at any time. IC VOLUNTEERS - NEW DIOCESAN POLICY

Dear Immaculate Conception School and Parish Volunteers, As part of our commitment to keeping all children safe, **the Diocese of Columbus has recently updated its Safe Environment policies.** The following updates involve all Immaculate Conception School and Parish volunteers over the age of 18, who work with minors.

- All volunteers who have lived in the state of Ohio for 5 years or more, must have a current BCI background check and have completed VIRTUS Protecting God's Children training.
- All volunteers who have lived in Ohio for fewer than 5 years, need to complete a FBI and BCI as well as have completed VIRTUS Protecting God's Children training.
- This policy update requires all volunteers to renew their BCI fingerprints every five years thereafter.
- All background checks, including FBI and BCI, need to be sent directly to the State of Ohio and to the Diocese of Columbus Safe Environment Office.

In accordance with Bishop Fernandes' guidelines, this policy will take full effect on January 1, 2026, allowing time for everyone to become compliant. If your BCI check was last completed prior to January, 2021, you will need to obtain a new background check. Please note that no one may begin volunteering within the Diocese of Columbus until all Safe Environment requirements are complete and documented in VIRTUS. To check the status of your BCI background check and ensure it is compliant, log into VIRTUS at https://virtusonline.org/virtus/.

We are so grateful for all the ways you give your time and talents to our school and parish. Your support makes such a difference, and this process helps us continue to provide a safe and welcoming environment for all of our students.


