**AN UPDATE ON PARISH/SCHOOL FACILITIES**

Thanks to the ongoing generosity of our IC parish community, we have been able to address the following day-to-day repairs and maintenance of our campus facilities, as well as complete some significant projects. Since last summer, we resealed the south Rose Window in the church, trimmed and pruned over 14 trees and shrubs on campus, and repaired and replaced the flooring in 3 classrooms in our school. Also, a significant repair/replacement, we replaced the shingle roof over the Gathering Space in August 2025, and in February 2026, we completed a new layover rubber flat roof over Marian Hall, giving it new life and a 20-year warranty. In 2025, we replaced and repaired the fallen coping stones over the south school entrance, and repainted the entire gym, stage and hallway areas of our school during the summer of 2024.

In the summer of 2024, we installed an automatic "changeover" valve for the HVAC system in the church. This allows the heat to work when it's cold outside and when the temps warm up, the valve allows the system to automatically change over to cooling. This used to be a manual procedure and has been a fantastic update.

We will soon replace our fire alarm panel in the school that needs an upgrade to bring it up to code.

Due to your regular and ongoing offertory and financial support, we have been able to accomplish these repairs and upgrades. We thank you very much!!

The priest is going to read the Gospel at the beginning of Mass today. Jesus goes into Jerusalem, riding on a colt, as people wave palm branches and shout, "Hosanna!" Hosanna means, "Hooray!"

# FAITH FORMATION

Immaculate Conception Church

March 29, 2026



Riding on the borrowed donkey, Jesus made His humble entrance into the city while the crowds were scattering their garments before Him and waving their palm branches. This joyful scene belies the traitorous acts, sorrow and agony that will soon follow, belies that this triumphant hero will be crucified like a criminal.

St. Bernard of Clairvaux (1090-1153) offered a homily about Christ's entry into Jerusalem: "How different the cries, 'Away with him, away with him, crucify him,' and then,

'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, hosanna, in the highest!' How different the cries are that now are calling him 'King of Israel' and then in a few days' time will be saying, 'We have no king but Caesar!' What a contrast between the green branches and the cross, between the flowers and the thorns! Before they were offering their own clothes for him to walk upon, and so soon afterwards they are stripping him of his, and casting lots upon them."

**On Palm Sunday, we still go out to meet Him, carry the blessed palms, joyfully sing out our hosanna and join in His triumphant entrance into Jerusalem. But soon our joy turns to somberness as, clutching our palm, we hear the narrative of Christ's passion. We realize, once again, that His triumph, His true victory, will come through the cross. We know, as Jesus did, how Holy Week will end. We know that joy will turn to sorrow and back to joy. We know that through the horror of His suffering, followed by the glory of His resurrection, good will trump evil and life will trump death.**

**The palms we take home and put in a special place serve to remind us that Palm Sunday is not lost to the ages but that by Christ's victory we, too, can achieve everlasting life. "For us too, they [palms] must be symbols of triumph, indicative of the victory to be won in our battle against the evil in ourselves and against the evil which roams about us. As we receive the blessed palm, let us renew our pledge to conquer with Jesus, but let us not forget that it was on the cross that He conquered." Simplycatholic.org**



**On the night of Holy Thursday, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place where the faithful remain in the presence of the Eucharist just as the Disciples kept vigil with Christ.**

**Please consider joining others to pray on this special night in the church, as we keep watch with Jesus.**

**I accept Your gentle invitation of love, dear Lord, to spend this night in vigil with You. May I enter Your Heart as it faced the coming persecution You were to endure for my sins. May I console Your Sacred Heart and know the love and Mercy that flowed forth.**

*The Sacred Paschal Triduum is the three most solemn days of the liturgical year; Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. These most holy days celebrate the Paschal Mystery, first, the passion, suffering, and death of the Lord Jesus, followed by his resurrection, the triumph of the holy cross, and Christ's decisive victory over sin and death. The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Sacred Paschal Triduum. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The Paschal Mystery is Christ's work of redemption accomplished principally by His Passion, death, and Resurrection. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil. [www.veritasph.net](http://www.veritasph.net)*

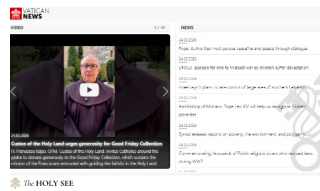

**A NEW WIDGET ON THE IC WEBSITE!?**

**What is a widget?** A widget is a small application or tool that can be added to a website, computer desktop, or mobile device screen to provide specific functionalities or information. Widgets are typically designed to enhance user experience by providing quick access to commonly used features, real-time updates, or personalized content.



**And so...** A new widget has been added to the home page of IC's website featuring journalistic articles with reports on the Pope and on the main events that take place in Rome and in the Universal Church, but also material that can be used for pastoral

work, education, and prayer. This service will thus make it possible to strengthen the communion of American dioceses and parishes as well as all the dioceses and parishes worldwide wide with the Successor of St. Peter, a pressing need especially today in the era of fake, A.I.-generated content. The Vatican considers this initiative important and urgent also in view of the fact that the Pontiff's mother tongue is English and, for the first time in history, the Pastor of the Universal Church is a citizen of the United States.

**NOW HIRING TOTUS TUUS MISSIONARIES**

The Department of Evangelization and Catechesis would like to share this opportunity for young adults interested in serving as missionaries for Totus Tuus during the summer of 2026. Totus Tuus Missionaries are young adults 18 and older who have graduated from high school by May 2026. The commitment is from May 28-July 24 and missionaries are paid a stipend. Each missionary will serve with three other young adults at parishes throughout Ohio and Northern Kentucky. They will spend one week at each scheduled parish working with students in Grades 1-12. This year, they will teach about The Ten Commandments and the Luminous Mysteries. Ideal candidates for Totus Tuus are those strongly committed to their Catholic Faith, have an active daily prayer life, are discerning their future vocation, and enjoy teaching the faith to young people. PGC compliance is required and formation for this summer missionary work will be provided. **WANT TO HELP ADULT LEARNERS?**

Assisting adult learners on their academic journeys is one way to improve self-confidence and break the cycle of poverty. The Dominican Learning Center, a ministry of the Dominican Sisters of Peace, is seeking volunteer tutors to help adult learners in our community with GED preparation, Adult Basic Education, and English as a Second Language (ESL). No prior teaching experience is required – just a willingness to walk alongside someone as they learn. Training and all materials are provided, and tutoring can be in-person or remote.
