
LOW-GLUTEN HOSTS

It is unfortunate so many do not realize this. Therefore, you and I must proclaim it to the world - from the mountain tops!

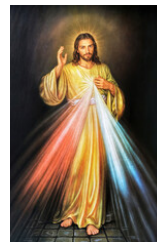

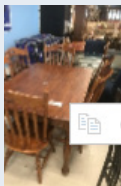
ST. VINCENT DE PAUL 5TH SUNDAY COLLECTION

We are now accepting donations for the IC St. Vincent de Paul Society so they can continue to help neighbors in financial crisis, or in need. Here is just one example of your donations at work. Mother in need – SVDP at Immaculate Conception outreach.

Ms. A..... contacted our conference via our assistance line (624) 594-3603 asking for help with an electrical service shut off. Two of our conference members made a home visit to evaluate our ability to assist. Ms. A is the mother of four daughters aged 12 to 17 who are all in middle or high school and each have special needs for either physical or emotional reasons. Ms. A has lived in the same location for six years but suffered a breakdown after the death of her son, the oldest child, followed the next year by her mother, her biggest supporter and confidant. Her father is no help to her and the father of the daughters is in prison. The breakdown left her in a continual cycle of mania and depression, and things got out of control. While her mental health has stabilized, her financial status has not. She was working with social services to straighten out her lapse from Section 8 voucher system and fell behind on the electrical service bill. Our team reviewed her financial situation, her interaction with other resources and social services.

The conference reviewed the home visit report and arranged for payment of the past-due electrical bill and decided to stay in touch on the outcome of the housing issue. While the team was there, it was noted that they had no dining table and were using a card table for meals and homework. The conference reached out to SVDP Thrift at 5969 E. Main and arranged for a table and six chairs to be delivered through the store's Neighbor to Neighbor program.

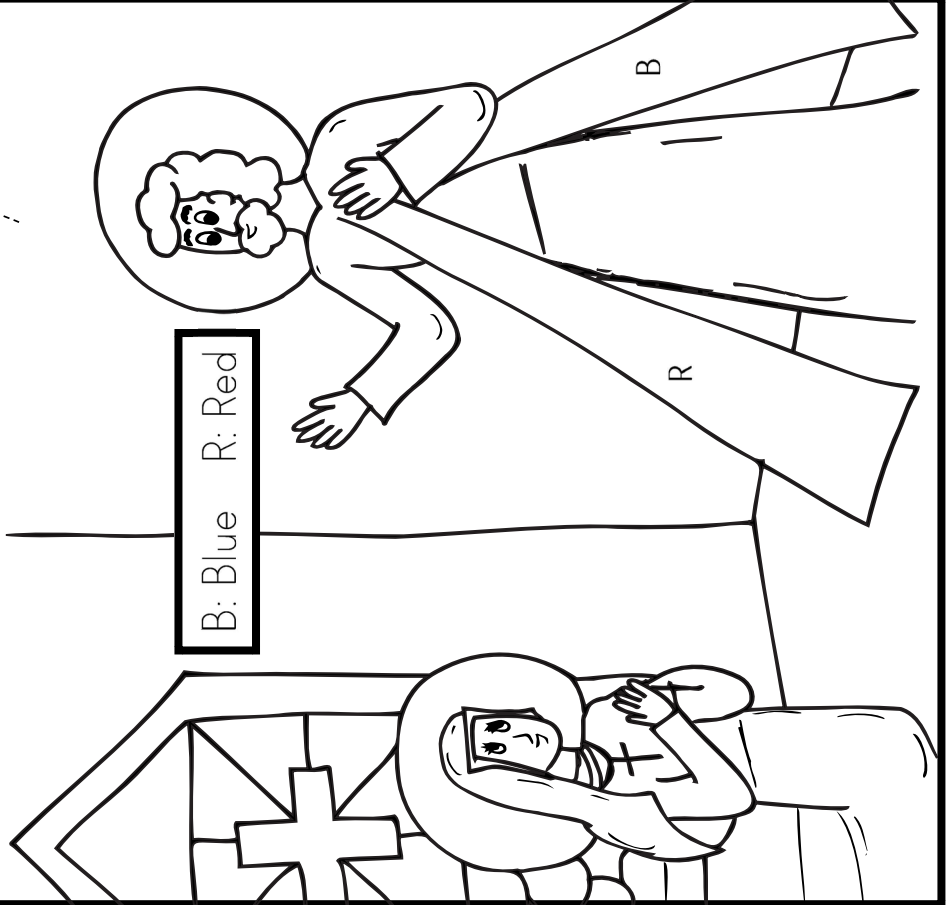

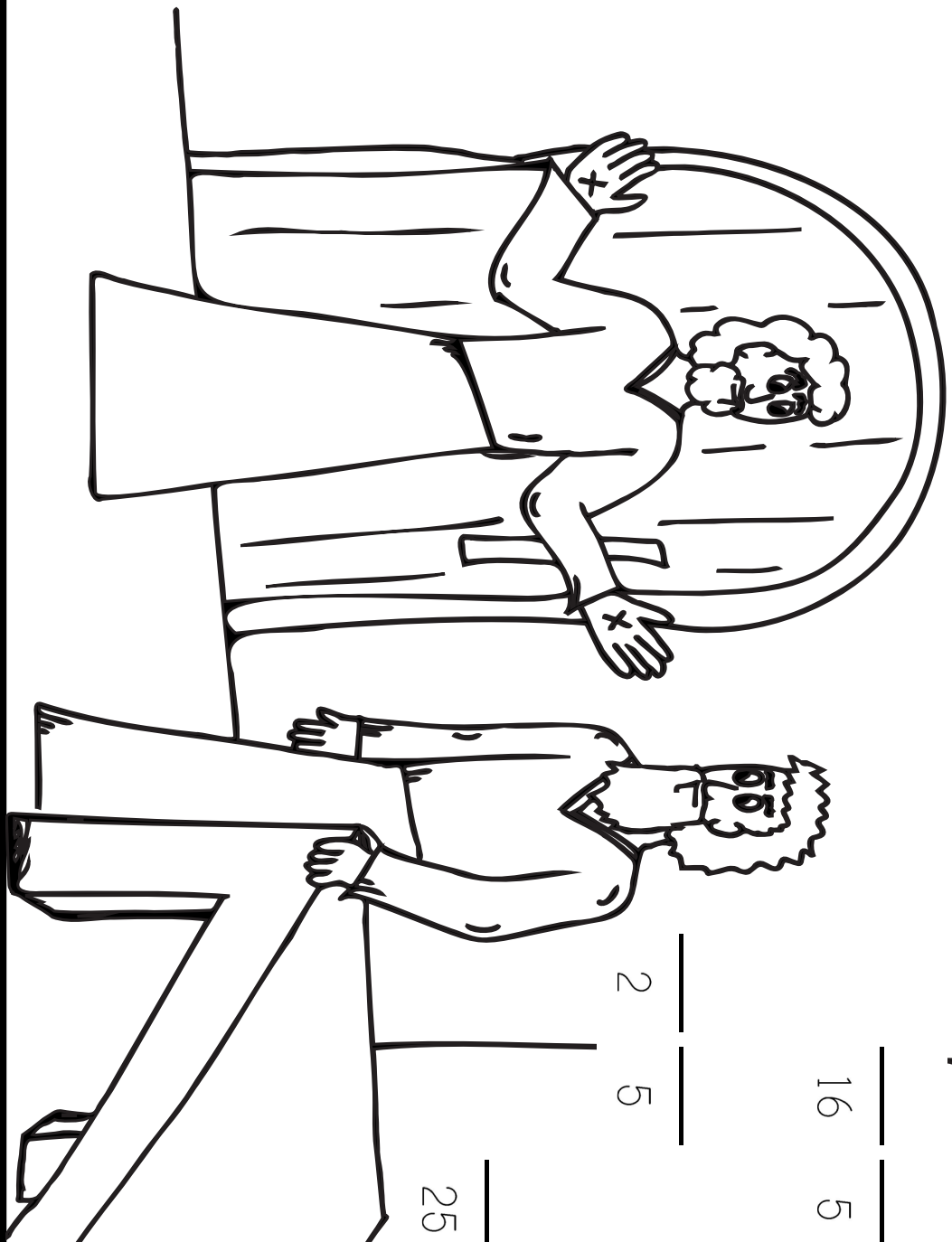
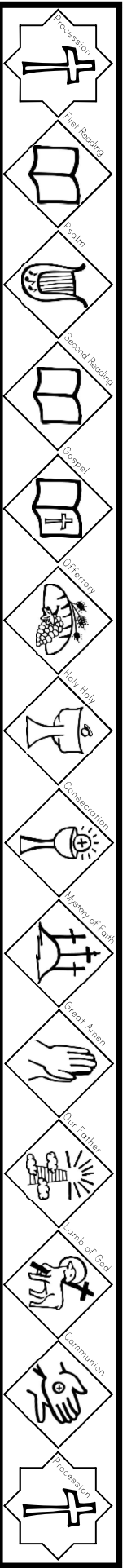

What Divine Mercy Means for Catholics Today

Divine Mercy is not just a devotion. It is a way of seeing God — and a way of seeing ourselves in relation to Him. Three truths are at its heart: God's mercy is infinite and unconditional. No sin is greater than His desire to forgive. As Jesus told Faustina: "The greater the sinner, the greater the right he has to My mercy."

Trust is the key. Divine Mercy is not received passively — it requires an act of trust. "Jesus, I trust in You" is not merely a phrase. It is a surrender, a choice to believe that God's love is stronger than our failures.

Mercy received must become mercy given. Jesus asked Faustina not only to receive His mercy but to practice it — through deed, word, and prayer. We are called to be instruments of His mercy to others.

The image of Divine Mercy — Jesus with two rays flowing from His heart, one red and one white — represents the blood and water that flowed from His side on the Cross. Beneath the image, the words: "Jesus, I trust in You."

It's a whole **50-day season** meant to help us truly live in the joy of the Resurrection. But let's be honest... after the chocolate bunnies disappear and life slips back into routine, it can be hard to keep that Easter spirit alive.

Here are simple, practical, everyday ways to keep the Resurrection burning in your heart all season long.

Start Your Day With an Alleluia: Living the Easter Season Daily

During Lent we quietly put away the Alleluia... but now it's time to bring it back! Begin your mornings with a quick prayer like: **"Jesus, thank You for rising. Help me rise today too."** Just one joyful moment sets the tone for the whole day.

Bring Light Into Your Home to Celebrate Living the Easter Season

Easter is all about light overcoming darkness. Open your curtains, light a candle during prayer, or place a small white cloth or flowers near a crucifix or image of Jesus. Little reminders can shift your mindset toward hope.

Read the Gospels of the Resurrection: A Key to Living the Easter Season

Take a few minutes each week to read the Resurrection stories, John 20, Luke 24, Mark 16, Matthew 28. You'll find something new every time, and the joy of the disciples becomes contagious.

Choose One Way to "Rise" Each Day While Living the Easter Season

Ask yourself each morning: **"How can I live like someone who believes in the Resurrection today?"**

Maybe it's: Letting go of a small resentment, calling someone who might feel alone, choosing patience or doing an act of charity quietly.

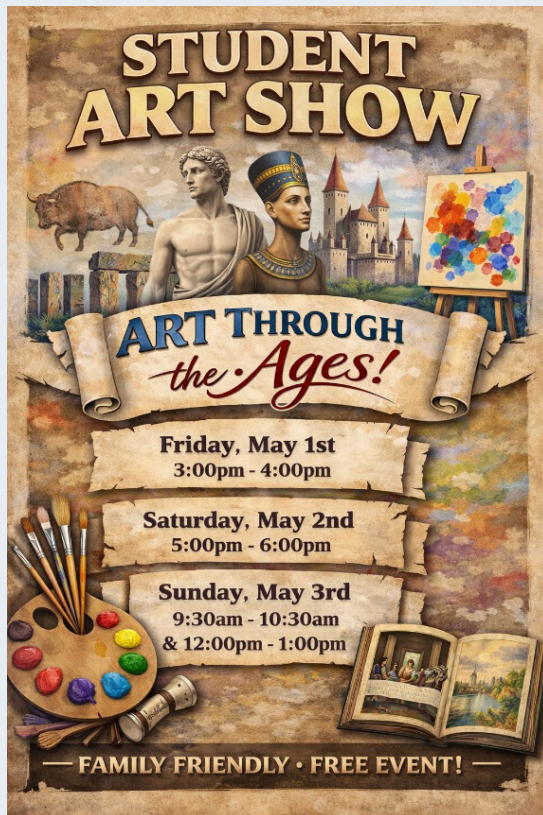
