Your SVdP conference at Immaculate Conception has helped more than 35 families with utility and rental assistance this year. In each case, the assistance was provided as the result of a home visit by two Vincentians from our conference. One of the hallmarks of the Society is the home visit. We do not just funnel support, we meet with the neighbor, listen to their immediate needs and also to their deeper needs. We try to offer immediate short-term support to them and point them to additional resources and financial counseling. In addition, we have provided more than 1,000 sandwiches to the Holy Family soup kitchen, made by our conference of the 4th Monday of each month. We also make food calls to neighbors who are having trouble with both a shortage of food and an inability get out to stores and food pantries. These shut-in food calls provide food from our pantry and some fresh items purchased at the local grocery and delivered.

Saint Aloysius Gonzaga

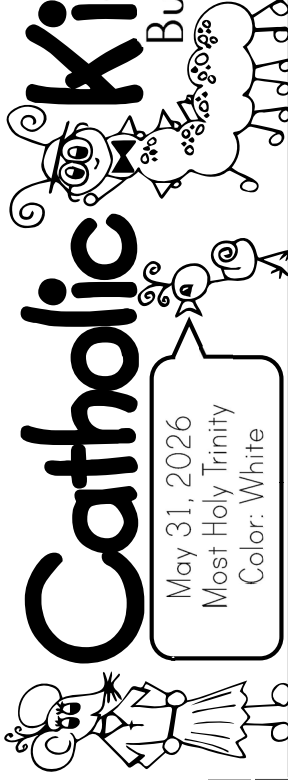

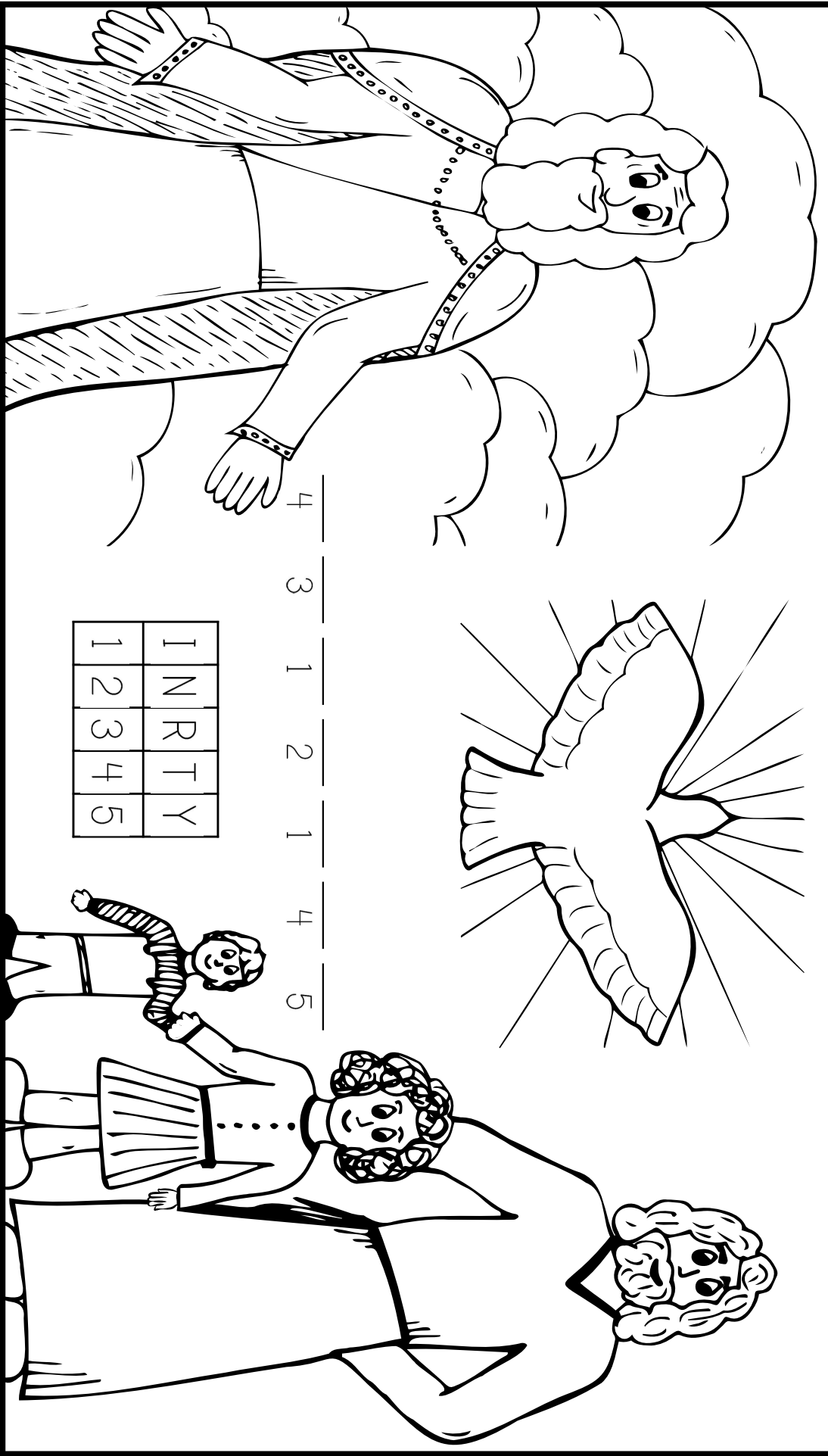
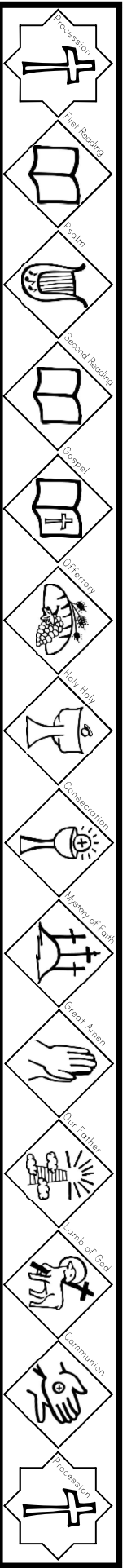

Gospel

Today, we learn about the Trinity. The Trinity means that we have three names for one God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. They are all God. We remember this when we pray the Sign of the Cross.

Immaculate Conception Church

Today's Gospel (Cf. John 3:16-18), feast of the Most Holy Trinity, shows in John's synthetic language the mystery of God's love for the world, His creation. In the brief dialogue with Nicodemus, Jesus presents himself as He who brings to fulfillment the Father's plan of salvation for the world. He affirms: "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son" (v. 16). These words indicate that the action of the three Divine Persons — Father, Son and Holy Spirit — is altogether a single design of love that saves humanity and the world; it is a design of salvation for us.

Dear brothers and sisters, today's feast invites us to let ourselves be fascinated again by God's beauty; inexhaustible beauty, goodness, and truth. But also beauty, goodness, and truth that is humble, close, who made Himself flesh to enter in our life, in our history, in my history, in the history of each one of us, so that every man and woman can encounter Him and have eternal life. And this is faith: to receive God-Love, to receive this God-Love who gives Himself in Christ, who makes us move in the Holy Spirit; to let ourselves be encountered by Him and to trust in Him. This is the Christian life. To love, encounter God, seek God, but He seeks us first, He meets us first. Pope Francis Angelus address on the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity.



US Bishops to consecrate America to Sacred Heart of Jesus for 250th anniversary

As part of their assembly, the Bishops will concelebrate Mass and consecrate the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The act of consecration will take place on Thursday, June 11, and the Bishops will hear reflections on the Sacred Heart ahead of the Mass. The consecration comes as the US celebrates the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence on July 4.

May your holy Catholic Church serve as a sign, pointing all people to your infinite love.

Who live and reign with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

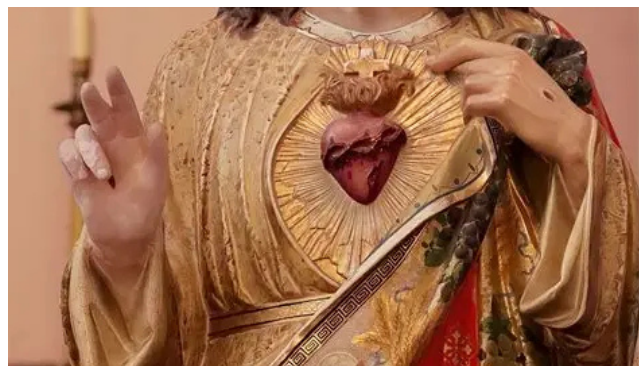

For generations, our summer Festival has been one of the most loved traditions in our parish and school community. It brings together families, friends, alumni, neighbors, and parishioners for a weekend full of fellowship, fun, and memories, while also serving as one of the parish's most important fundraisers each year.

As we look ahead to summer 2027, we are prayerfully seeking one or two couples to step forward to serve as Festival Chairs.

The role primarily involves:

- Leading monthly planning meetings from February through July
- Checking in periodically with area chairs throughout the planning process
- Communicating updates with the Parish Office
- Being available during Festival week for deliveries, setup, and helping wherever needed during the event

While it is certainly a commitment, you will not be doing it alone. The structure is already in place, and there is strong support built into the process. New chairs would shadow during this year's Festival and planning season, then officially take over the following year with continued support from outgoing chairs as well as your own incoming shadow chairs.

Serving as Festival Chair is a meaningful way to give back to the parish community and help preserve a tradition that means so much to so many families. It is incredibly rewarding to see the community come together because of the work behind the scenes.

At this time, we also want to be honest with our parish and school families: If we are unable to find new leadership for the Festival, we may need to consider canceling the Festival for 2027 or exploring a very different model moving forward.

Your SVdP conference at Immaculate Conception has helped more than 35 families with utility and rental assistance this year. We try to offer immediate short-term support to them and point them to additional resources and financial counseling. In addition, we have provided more than 1,000 sandwiches to the Holy Family soup kitchen, made by our conference of the 4th Monday of each month. We also make food calls to neighbors who are having trouble with both a shortage of food and an inability get out to stores and food pantries. These shut-in food calls provide food from our pantry and some fresh items purchased at the local grocery and delivered.

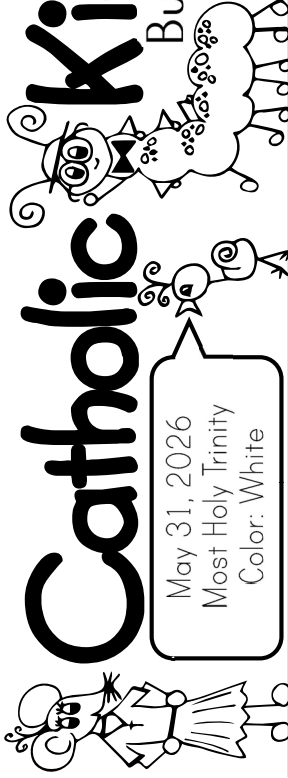

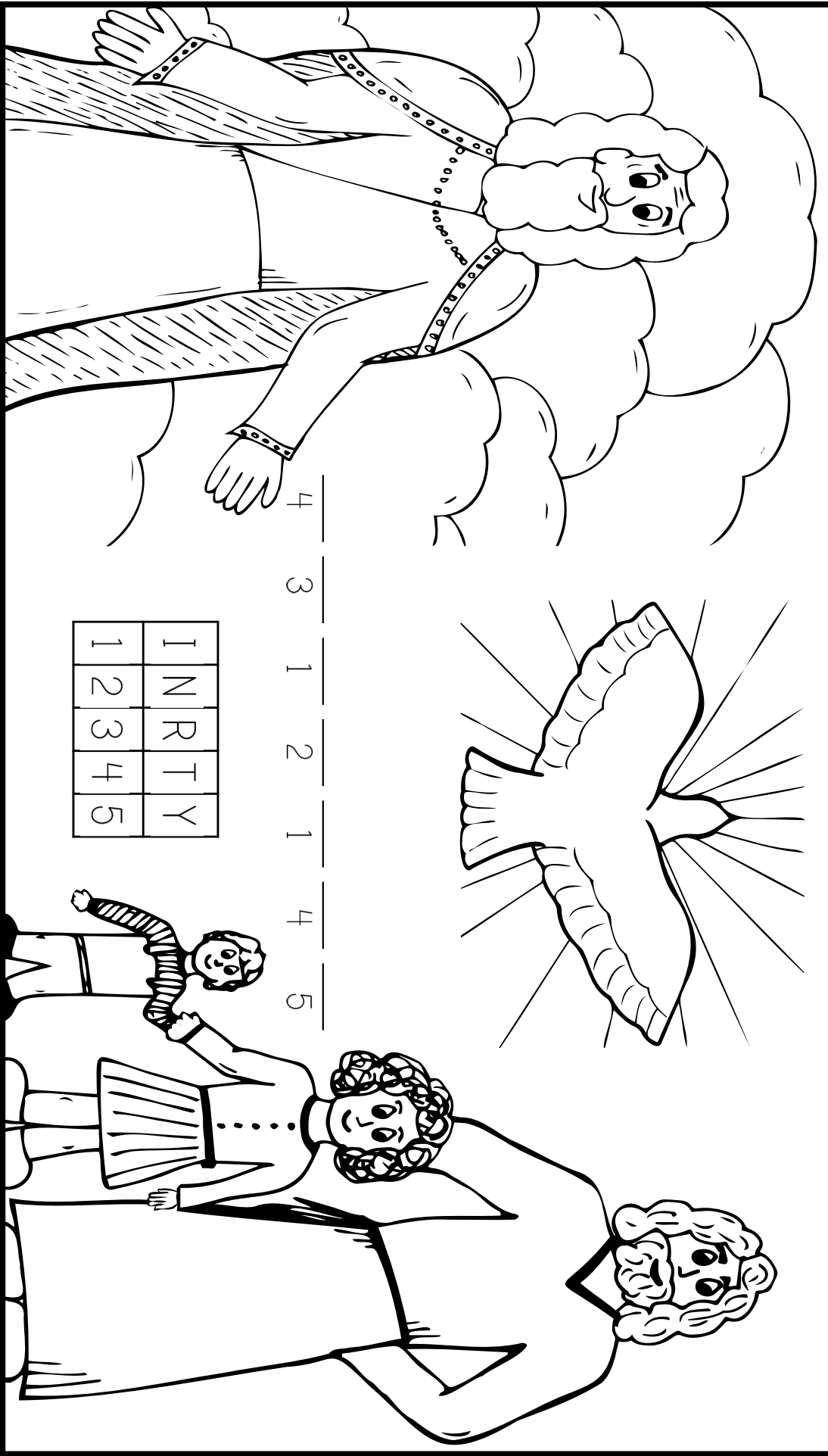
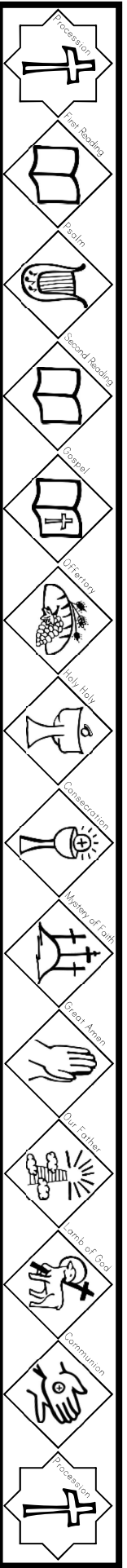

Today, we learn about the Trinity. The Trinity means that we have three names for one God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. They are all God. We remember this when we pray the Sign of the Cross.

Immaculate Conception Church

May 31, 2026

Today's Gospel (Cf. John 3:16-18), feast of the Most Holy Trinity, shows in John's synthetic language the mystery of God's love for the world, His creation. In the brief dialogue with Nicodemus, Jesus presents himself as He who brings to fulfillment the Father's plan of salvation for the world. He affirms: "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son" (v. 16). These words indicate that the action of the three Divine Persons — Father, Son and Holy Spirit — is altogether a single design of love that saves humanity and the world; it is a design of salvation for us.

Dear brothers and sisters, today's feast invites us to let ourselves be fascinated again by God's beauty; inexhaustible beauty, goodness, and truth. But also beauty, goodness, and truth that is humble, close, who made Himself flesh to enter in our life, in our history, in my history, in the history of each one of us, so that every man and woman can encounter Him and have eternal life. And this is faith: to receive God-Love, to receive this God-Love who gives Himself in Christ, who makes us move in the Holy Spirit; to let ourselves be encountered by Him and to trust in Him. This is the Christian life. To love, encounter God, seek God, but He seeks us first, He meets us first. Pope Francis Angelus address on the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity.

Who live and reign with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

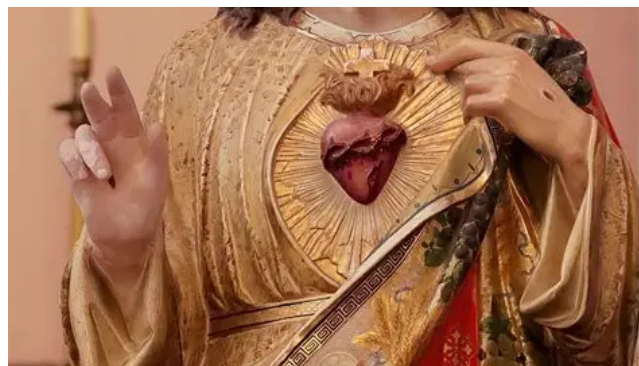
