Feast of St. Peter and Paul June 29



The experience and witness of Saints Peter and Paul can be an encouragement to us on our journey through life. Let us look back for a moment at the liturgical journey we have completed so far (having just celebrated Pentecost, and then the Solemnities of the Most Holy Trinity and of Corpus Christi): Today, we are offered the opportunity of celebrating the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, as if to remind us that it is the gift of the Holy Spirit that impels us, as it once did Saints Peter and Paul, to bear witness to all that God the Trinity is Love; it was the Holy Spirit who instilled in the disciples the courage to come together, running all the risks of that period, to celebrate the Eucharist on the day of the Lord's Resurrection; it was the Holy Spirit who made them understand that "Without the Eucharist we cannot live", even at the cost of death. And so Peter, apparently so weak, will die for the Lord Jesus in Rome; and Paul, the persecutor, will likewise die for the One who died for him. May these two great saints help us to find the courage to love as they loved, following the example of Jesus, our Lord.

Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood. Let us embrace what they believed, their life, their labors, their sufferings, their preaching, and their confession of faith. ~Saint Augustine of Hippo



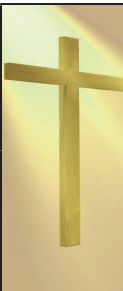
