Gospel

In today's Gospel, Jesus talks about Heaven. He says Heaven is even better than finding a hidden treasure.

The
**KINGDOM
OF HEAVEN**
is like a treasure
buried in a field

In the first parable, a person unexpectedly discovers a treasure buried in a field. Imagine that you take a metal detector with you while on a hike, simply curious about what might lie beneath the soil. Suddenly, the detector gives a strong signal. Expecting perhaps a rusted can or an old nail, you begin to dig. But as your shovel strikes something solid, you uncover an old chest. With growing anticipation, you lift it from the earth and open it—only to find it brimming with ancient and priceless jewels, gold and silver coins, and other precious items of immense worth.

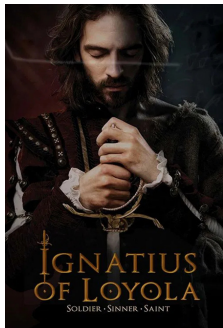
In the second parable, the merchant is actively searching for a valuable pearl. He knows what he seeks and finally discovers one of exceptional worth—one that eclipses all others. In both cases, however, the response is the same: the man and the merchant each go and sell all they possess to obtain the treasure they have found.

These parables pose two fundamental questions for each of us:

Have I discovered the priceless treasure of the Kingdom of Heaven?

If I have, am I willing to let go of everything else to attain it?

Like the man who stumbles upon the buried treasure, many people encounter God's grace in surprising ways—through a moment of prayer, a profound experience at Mass, an act of charity, or even during suffering. Maybe those people were not actively seeking divine treasure, yet in a moment of providence, the veil is lifted, and the beauty of God's Kingdom is revealed. Once they discover the treasure, their souls realize that nothing else compares. From that point on, they are moved to reorient their entire lives to possess that treasure. The path of the merchant, by contrast, is that of the soul who longs for truth, beauty, and goodness, diligently seeking them out. The one who searches might spend years studying, praying, yearning, and pursuing what is of eternal value. And then—finally—the “pearl” is found. Christ is discovered. The Gospel becomes clear. The longing is fulfilled. Again, everything else is willingly surrendered for the sake of that one Pearl of great price—Jesus Christ. mycatholiclife.org

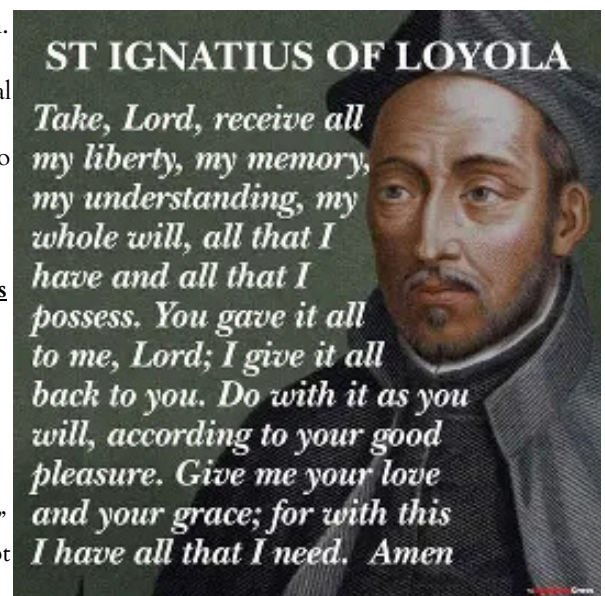
The Feast Day of St. Ignatius of Loyola is celebrated on July 31. St. Ignatius of Loyola was born the youngest of 13 children in a family castle in Guipuzcoa, Spain.

Until he was 30, he served as a courtier and soldier in Spain.

St. Ignatius was wounded when a cannonball shattered his leg. While in the hospital he spent a great deal of time studying the lives of the saints. When he was finally released from the hospital, he decided he should try to imitate the saints. He went to confession, and then lived in a cave for about a year while caring for the poor and sick.

He entered school at the age of 35. After studying Latin and theology in several different schools, he received his degree in Paris. While in Paris, he met St. Francis Xavier who was one of his followers. Ignatius, with five followers founded the Order of the Society of Jesus, which came to be known as the Jesuits. They offered themselves to the Pope, for any work he wanted them to do. The Jesuits were known for their missionary work. They were a great influence during the Counter Reformation.

St. Ignatius was a mystic. He had several visions. His spirituality focused on the Trinity, Christ and the Eucharist. His motto was “All for the greater glory of God.” In 1548, his book The Spiritual Exercises was printed. This introduces the concept of a 30-day retreat.



CONFIRMATION PREPARATION NEWS

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

In the Spring of 2025, the decision was made in our Diocese to lower the Confirmation age to 4th grade.

Immaculate Conception Parish and School will implement a stair-step approach over the next few years to achieve this goal. Confirmation Liturgies are still planned to happen in the winter; however no definitive date has been set at this time. **Please refer to the timeline below:**

- **2027 – 7th and 8th Graders**
- **2028 – 6th and 7th Graders**
- **2029 – 5th and 6th Graders**
- **2030 – 4th and 5th Graders**
- **2031 and Beyond – 4th Graders**

However, if you see readiness in your child to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation prior to his or her scheduled year, please feel free to reach out to the Parish Office.

Requirements for Confirmation for 2026/2027:

- **Parent night: September 2, 2026, at 7 p.m. in Marian Hall.**
 - Attend all formation classes held on the following Sundays. These classes are intended for the student and parent; these sessions complement one another and are presented separately but during the same time.
 - September 13, 2026, 9:45-10:45 a.m.
 - September 20, 2026, 9:45-10:45 a.m.
 - September 27, 2026, 9:45-10:45 a.m.
 - October 4, 2026, 9:45-10:45 a.m.
 - October 11, 2026, 9:45-10:45 a.m.
 - October 18, 2026, 9:45-10:45 a.m.
 - There is a Confirmation retreat for the students held at Damacus Catholic Mission camp located in Centerburg, Ohio. This is an overnight weekend camp held October 31 through November 1, 2026. There will be a fee for non-Immaculate Conception School students to attend this retreat. Registration for this camp will be required; **Non-Immaculate Conception School students** should contact Mary Ann Rivera for registration information at marivera@iccols.org for both the retreat and registering for Confirmation preparation.

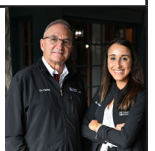
