THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE: THOUGHTS FROM FR. KELLER

Greetings in the Lord!

As I write this, we are preparing to start school here at Immaculate Conception. We are excited to begin the academic year and welcome our students back. The teachers and staff have been diligently preparing, and we look forward to having a wonderful school year. This preparation has been both practical and spiritual. All the teachers from across the Diocese of Columbus attended a retreat day at St. Charles on August 17 where the theme was on the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist, particularly the celebration of the Holy Eucharist (i.e., the Mass), is at the center of our life as Catholics. The Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1324, echoing the Second Vatican Council, calls the Eucharist "the source and summit of the Christian life." It is the source, from which all the grace and life of the Church flows. It is also the summit, the greatest activity of the Church, which is to worship God by making present the power and benefit of the once-for-all sacrifice of Christ on the Cross. It is that to which all the Church's activity is directed. The Eucharist is at the beginning and end of our Christian life, as it were. We come to Mass and are given strength and spiritual nourishment on our journey to eternity. We go forth from Mass as disciples of Christ in the world, seeking to draw others to the Supper of the Lamb, always returning to this source of life as the greatest prayer we can offer, because it is not our work, but the work of Christ. This school year we hope to instill an ever-greater love of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament in our young people. But this is something that we all need to be constantly renewed in, lest we grow too familiar with (or used to) the Eucharist, forgetting the great gift that it is.

A moment ago, I noted the need to draw others to the Eucharist. It is part of the mission of every baptized Catholic to spread the faith and to invite others to belong to the Church that Christ founded. With this in mind, **I am personally asking every parishioner to invite 2-3 people to consider learning more about the Catholic faith and possibly joining the Church at the Easter Vigil.** We are already blessed with about a dozen people in formation to enter the Church through the OCIA process (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults). However, if every parishioner extends a couple of invitations, there is no reason why we shouldn't have 40 or 50 people in the OCIA class. Almost everyone who enters the Church does so, at least in part, because they know a Catholic who is a good witness to their faith. You could be the reason that someone finds the fullness of God's grace and truth in His Catholic Church. There are cards at the entrances to the church that contain the contact information for OCIA. All that you have to do is extend a friendly invitation to a few neighbors, co-workers, family members, or friends and hand them the card. The rest is up to them and is in the hands of God. The classes officially start on September 8. I hope that you will prayerfully consider whom to invite and extend the invitation in the next couple of weeks.

Let us keep each other in prayer. A blessed week to you all!

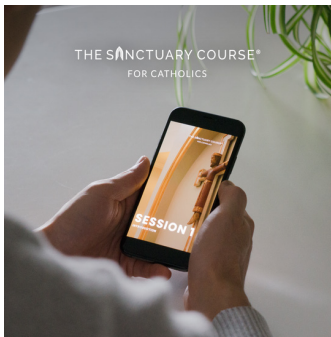

SECOND COLLECTION FOR DIOCESAN FLOOD VICTIMS NEXT WEEKEND!

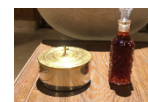

Immaculate Conception Church August 23, 2026



Jesus took the Twelve away from the comfort of their familiar fishing village and Jewish neighbors for a reason. He wanted them to answer His question not in the midst of the familiar and safe, but in a place marked by spiritual confusion and idolatry. Why? So that faith could be professed even there, and divine grace could confront the darkness that permeated the region.

At first, He asked who the people said He was. They answered, "Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." But then He posed the question that reached the heart of His mission: "But who do you say that I am?" This was a moment of divine testing—one which Simon passed with profound faith: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus' extraordinary and consequential response has enduring significance to this day.

He declared:

"Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father. And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" (Matthew 16:17-19).

With these sacred words, Jesus founded His Church upon Peter, making him the first pope. In biblical tradition, a change of name signifies a new mission and identity. Simon, son of Jonah, was now to be called Peter—*Petros* in Greek and *Cephas* in Aramaic—meaning "rock." Peter became the solid foundation upon which Christ's Church would be built. No pagan power, false god, or earthly ruler would ever overcome what Christ established with divine authority.

Saint Monica is revered as the patron saint of conversion due to her instrumental role in leading her own family members to Christianity.

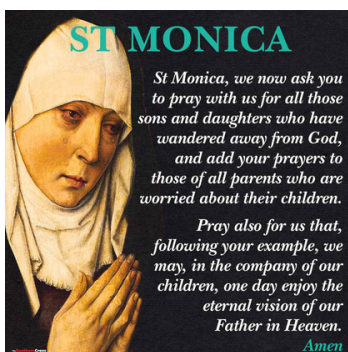

Here is a powerful prayer for the conversion of a wayward child, asking for Saint Monica's intercession:

Saint Augustine was a famous convert, who led a life of sin before dedicating his life to God. His mother spent many years praying for his conversion. St. Augustine's feast day is August 28th. Saint Augustine (354-430) created this prayer to the Holy Spirit that will ignite your heart for the love of God:

Short Prayer: Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit, That my thoughts may all be holy. Act in me, O Holy Spirit, That my work, too, may be holy. Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit, That I love but what is holy. Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit, To defend all that is holy. Guard me, then, O Holy Spirit, That I always may be holy. Amen
